Good news for folks looking for some rider education and CPR/First Aid courses where you can knock them all out in one weekend. The Arkansas GWRRA group is planning a series of courses April 20-22, 2007 in Morrilton, Arkansas. The activities will be held at the University of Arkansas at Morrilton, just off Interstate 40. A number of safety related courses will be offered at no cost while the field related courses will charge tuition. Most courses will be offered several times during the weekend to accommodate as many as is possible. Costs for example are: CPR/First Aid = \$25.00; ERC Refresher = \$50.00; ERC Trike course = \$35.00.
